**Parent Involvement Policy**

Southeast High School (SEHS) acknowledges reliable research proving that parental involvement raises the academic achievement of all students. SEHS will promote parental involvement by encouraging parent volunteers, hosting a parent resource room, and promoting an active PTSA. Parents will be encouraged and invited to attend and assist in SEHS activities involving all facets of the educational process for our students.

On the school website will be posted activities throughout the school year including a calendar that includes school activities. SEHS will have a minimum of two parent events quarterly which will include but not be limited to OKC District Open House, Parent-Teacher Conferences, Freshman/New Student Orientation, enrollment events, athletic parent nights, Career Day, Success beyond High School Night, and College and Career Night.

In order to build an effective home-school partnership, SEHS will provide the following:

- An annual orientation where parents will meet their child's teacher and be reminded of their right and responsibility to be involved in their child's education.
- An annual Freshman/New Student Orientation where parents and students will gain essential information to prepare for a positive experience at SEHS.
- Meetings and correspondence throughout the year to assist parents in understanding the federal and state academic content and student achievement standards as well as local academic assessments. Meetings will also focus on how parents and teachers can work together to monitor the child's progress in order to improve student achievement.
- A varied schedule for meetings and conferences in order to accommodate the needs of parents.
- A minimum of two scheduled parent conferences, where the progress of the student will be discussed as well as the expectations for the grade level, school curriculum, test information, and any other concerns that the teacher or parent may have.
- Continuous communication to assist parents in understanding the school curriculum and student achievement, School Report Card, OKCPS Parent-Pupil Handbook, SEHS Student Planner, as well as handouts, flyers, brochures, and student achievement reports.
- A school-parent compact that outlines how parents, school staff, and students share the responsibility for improving learning.

Periodically, a parent survey shall be conducted to collect parent opinions and concerns about the current programs and to collect suggestions for improvement as well topics for meetings that address their needs.
